Student Guidelines

Scholarships awards available:

• 2020 – Four (4) scholarships are available in the amount of \$4,000; \$3,000; \$2,000; and \$1,000.

Who is eligible?

- Applicant must be classified as a full-time student in their sophomore, junior or senior year during time of application process.
- Applicant must be classified as a full-time junior or senior at the time funds are disbursed.

How do I apply?

• Complete this application form and other requested information. Mail or email completed forms and materials to *Minnesota Construction Association, Attn: Scholarship Committee, 4248 Park Glen Road, Minneapolis, MN 55416* or info@mnconstruction.org.

What information do you need?

- All applicants must provide a transcript of college grades and a summary of activities and accomplishments. Applicants also must provide a written statement on future goals and why he or she should be considered for a scholarship award.
- When grade point and extracurricular activities are comparable between students, the judges attach significant weight to the student's personal written statement.

When will awards be announced?

• Following the confirmation from the Minnesota Construction Association, the award recipients will be announced late summer.

Will the award cover all costs?

• Maximum value of each full award is \$4,000; \$3,000; \$2,000 or \$1,000 payable in a lump sum payment. Scholarships funds may be used to pay all normal college expenses including tuition, room and board, book purchases and rentals. Fees, which are refundable, will not be paid.

How will the scholarship be awarded?

• Scholarship awards will be sent to the college of your enrollment during the month of August 2020. The amount will be credited to your account.



Information Requirements

<u>Information you need to prepare</u>: (All materials must be typed in order to be considered, no handwritten materials will be accepted)

- Complete the application completely, accurately, and submit on time. <u>Deadline: May 29, 2020</u>
- Complete the application form (page 6 of this document).
- Include the following with your application (additional details/requirements for submission are included on pages 4-5)
 - Personal Statement: Write a personal statement expressing your comments regarding your future goals and why you should receive this scholarship.
 - Complete an activities summary.
 - Complete a future plans summary.
 - Provide a summary of your leadership activities.
- All applicants must provide a transcript of college grades (include transfer schools). Included must be noted your current year i.e. sophomore second semester and your accumulated GPA as well as your most current last semester GPA.
- Ask your professor, former employer or supervisor to complete a personal reference regarding your skills and qualifications (additional details/requirements for submission are included on page 7).
- Student membership with MCA is not required, but is strongly encouraged and may be a determining
 factor in scholarship recipient selection. Student membership is free and the application is available
 online at www.mnconstruction.org/join.
- Materials must be sent via U.S. mail, FedEx or UPS or emailed (<u>postmark is used for deadline date</u>). No in-person materials will be accepted.
- You are responsible for all information being included with your application materials.
