The Minnesota Construction Association is thrilled to announce the recipient of the 2021 Choice Award is RJM for the Hero Center project in Woodbury, MN!

The Hero Center (Health & Emergency Response Occupations) training center in Cottage Grove is a 47,000-square-foot facility that will be a magnet for federal, state and local law enforcement officers. The center has training areas for all types of personnel including first responders, fire fighters and police. The center also includes a 2-acre training area for police dogs. The Center has areas that can be easily changed (walls, doors, or windows) for officers to see different situations.

This was a B3 Sustainable Project that had requirements for the project to have a minimum of 75% waste divergent which was achieved. The project was unique in the way it brought two different cities (Woodbury & Cottage Grove) and the state of Minnesota for its funding needs. The project had multiple city representatives heavily involved in the project that displayed great teamwork.

With the building having two different shooting ranges, there will be a lot of ballistic material present which requires a specialty HVAC system.

The award, along with many others, will be presented at the 2021 MCA Awards of Excellence Gala on Wednesday, January 27th at 3:00 PM. More details about the project can be discovered at the virtual gala.

Kraus-Anderson (KA)

Expansion at Irondale High School – New Brighton, MN



Kraus-Anderson has completed a \$24.7 million expansion at Irondale High School in New Brighton. The extensive 77,700-square-foot additions feature six new flexible classrooms, break-out spaces, science lab and a contemporary 25,700-square-foot, 650-seat auditorium with dressing rooms and scene shops for use by students and community groups. Construction included the removal of the pool to accommodate a new fitness center and multipurpose area. Additions also included four open common spaces for students to collaborate, a large gathering space for community events, as well as a new 5,600-square-foot administration office.

Riverdale Church Interior Remodel – Andover, MN

Minnesota Masonic Homes OES Chapel – Bloomington, MN



This project used the structure of an existing chapel, and updated it to meet 21st century standards. The existing building showed years of damage from water infiltration. Complete tuckpointing and structural repairs addressed this. There was only one access from the lower level to the main floor. A wheelchair lift and ramps were added so that the space can now be accessed by all patrons. Finally, the aesthetic of the old chapel was dated. **Adolfson & Peterson Construction** touched every square inch: re-staining wood, adding new lighting, and building new finish walls.
